Dress Regulations for Tournaments

Club members entering tournaments should take note of a recent decision by the GWAS committee regarding dress regulations for tournaments.

*Judges in the GWAS region have been instructed that, as from 1st January 2015, at tournaments where GNAS / Archery GB (AGB) rule 307 (dress regulations) applies, the rule must be strictly enforced. **Under no circumstances will any archer wearing clothing which does not conform to the rule be permitted to shoot.** It is the responsibility of the individual archer to ensure that he or she complies with the rule.*

Most of the rule is self-explanatory, but a grey area (literally!) is the interpretation of the colour 'olive drab'. The term is of military origin, and covers a range of shades, but any shade of greyish or brownish green could be included. Therefore, archers are best advised to avoid any shade of green other than standard 'GNAS / AGB plain dark green'. No examples of the range of acceptable and/or unacceptable shades are currently available from AGB.

AGB rule 307 is automatically in force for Record Status tournaments. It also applies to National, Regional, and County tournaments (this includes Grand Day), and any other tournament for which the entry form specifies AGB rules.
